shapes	outline or form of something (or geometric shapes such as triangle, square and circles)
collage	using different materials or mediums to create an artwork
tint	shade or vanity of colour
prime	to prepare a surface for painting

paintbrushes


ready-mix paint

By mixing primary colours, you make secondary colours - green, orange and purple.
