White Star Line	<i>The company that owned the Titanic.</i>
Southampton	<i>A city in the UK, where the Titanic was launched.</i>
New York	<i>A city in the USA, where the Titanic was headed.</i>
Iceberg	<i>A floating piece of ice.</i>
Voyage	<i>A long journey by land, sea or space.</i>
Passenger	<i>A person who travels on public or private transport.</i>

Number on board	<i>2,223 (1,324 passengers, 885 crew)</i>
Cost	<i>\$7.5 million</i>
Building	<i>Took 3,000 men 3 years to build.</i>
Size	<i>Bigger than three football pitches.</i>

Time of key events	
29th July 1908	<i>The design for the Titanic is approved.</i>
31st March 1909	<i>Building on the Titanic begins in Belfast, Ireland.</i>
31st May 1911	<i>The hull of the Titanic is successfully launched.</i>
31st March 1912	<i>The Titanic is completed.</i>
3rd April 1912	<i>The Titanic arrives in Southampton.</i>
10th April 1912	<i>The Titanic begins her maiden voyage.</i>
11th April 1912	<i>The Titanic reaches Queenstown, Ireland.</i>
14th April 1912	<i>The Titanic hits an iceberg. In the early hours of 15th of April the huge ship sinks into the sea.</i>
