Key Vocabulary

mammal	Animals with fur, that feed their babies with milk.
bird	A warm-blooded, egg-laying animal with wings and feathers.
amphibian	A cold blooded animal with moist skin and webbed feet.
reptile	A cold blooded animal with scales and dry skin.
insect	A group of very small animals that have segmented bodies.
fish	Cold-blooded animals that live in water, have gills, fins, and a tail.
wild	Animals who live in nature and not tamed.
pet	Animals who are tamed and live in a home.

An animal that only likes to eat plants.
