

Social Network	Guru Top Tips
Allo	You can stop someone from sending inappropriate messages. Just tap on the contact and hit 'Block' for safe, fun messaging.
ASKfm	Remember you can easily block someone from asking you a question on ASKfm in the 'More' section of the app, this even covers anonymous questions.
BBM	BBM has a handy feature that let's you retract messages so the recipient can no longer see them. Just tap on 'Retract' in the message to ensure they can't be seen again.
Call of Duty	Remember to restrict in app purchases when playing this game. They can range from £1.99 to £99 and are simple for kids to do. Head to your settings page to make sure your kids and wallet are protected.
Clash of Clans	Remember to restrict in app purchases when playing this game. They can range from £1.99 to £99 and are simple for kids to do. Head to your settings page to make sure your kids and wallet are protected.
Dubsmash	Did you know once you remove a contact from the contact list it also blocks them from sending 'dubs' to you? Don't worry they can be re-added but this is a great way to ensure your kids are safe online.
Facebook & Facebook Messenger	It's really simple to block someone on Facebook. Just click on a contact and follow the prompts to block. They will not be able to send any inappropriate messages once this is done.
FaceTime	Don't forget, FaceTime allows you to block someone that is calling you. Just tap on the 'i' next to their name, scroll down and tap 'Block this Caller'.
FIFA Mobile	Remember to restrict in app purchases with FIFA Mobile. They can range from £1.99 to £99 and are simple for kids to do. Head to your settings page to make sure your kids and wallet are protected.
Flipagram	To stay safe with Flipagram, you can make your profile private by tapping on 'Edit profile' and then clicking 'Make profile private' this means no one will be able to search for you.
Friendlife	With Friendlife, you can block people you are following easily by tapping on the contact in your followers list and selecting 'Block'.
Glide	If you're worried about receiving inappropriate messages, long tap or swipe on the contact, then click 'More' then 'Block'. That user will not be able to contact you again.
Google Hangouts	If you're worried about receiving inappropriate messages, tap the three vertical dots and then 'People' then 'Block'. That user will not be able to contact you again.

Google+	Google+ let's you stop people or posts showing up on your timeline by tapping the post or person then tapping the three vertical dots in the top right hand corner. From here you can block the person and also report abuse.
IMVU	IMVU makes it simple to block online friends. Just tap on the contact, click 'More' and you can unfriend, block or report them.
Instagram	Instagram accounts can be made private so only your followers can see your activity. Simply go to the 'Account' tab and then tap the cog in the top right hand corner and tap the 'Private Account' toggle. Don't forget you can also block your followers if you don't want them to see your posts.
Kik	Kik is a bit trickier than other messaging apps. On iOS you can block someone from their contact by clicking on 'Info'. With Android you click on the main menu, head to 'Chat info' and click on the top right hand corner to block.
Kiwi	This app allows you to hide any inappropriate content from your feed. Just tap the left hand corner and toggle 'Filter Sensitive Media' and you won't get any nasty surprises popping up.
Live.ly	A bit of a tricky one, this free app allows you to do an in-app purchase of 'coins' to gift to other users. There is no way to block these but you can make your account private. Be cautious about purchases through this app.
Lovoo	Lovoo isn't the most secure app as it relies on location information, in app purchases and even when users are blocked they can view your profile but not contact you. To block someone click on 'Options' then 'Block'.
Minecraft Pocket Edition	Make sure you block possibly expensive in-app purchases in this popular children's game. They can range from £1.99 to £99 and are simple for kids to do. Head to your settings page to make sure your kids and wallet are protected.
MovieStarPlanet	MovieStarPlanet encourages In-App purchases but these are easily prevented. Head to your settings page on IOS or to your Playstore account for Android devices to ensure your kids and wallet are protected.
Musical.ly	Musical.ly is linked to the Live.ly app and is simple to block a user. Just head to their profile and select 'Block this user' to use this app safely.
MyLOL	This teen dating site has it's own section on online safety and even includes suspicious keyword checking as well as allowing users to be blocked by clicking on their profile and selecting report or block.
Omegle	Omegle has no security measures in place so we recommend avoiding this app.
ooVoo	ooVoo has a heap of privacy setting options, you can choose who and how people contact you as well as who can view your information. Head to settings and select privacy and security to look at options and make changes.
PenPal World	It's easy to block someone on PenPal World. You can click on 'Block' under the user's profile to ensure you aren't contacted by anyone you don't want.

Periscope	With Periscope, broadcasts are public by default and anyone viewing can share the broadcast on other social media. You can easily set your broadcast to private by tapping the 'lock' icon before starting to film. You can also block a user by going to their profile, tapping the 'gear' icon on the top left on iOS or the 'menu' icon on Android, and tapping 'Block User.'
Pinterest	Remember that images on Pinterest are searchable through Google so make sure you don't load any personal information. You can also hide your profile from searches by heading to 'Account Basics' and turning on 'Search Privacy'.

Roblox	You can add security for Roblox by turning on their 2 step verification. Every time you log in an email will be sent to you with a security code which you will need to enter when signing in.
Skype	Skype makes it simple to block a contact from messaging or calling you. Just tap on the contact's name which gives you a menu where you can block the contact.
Snapchat	Snapchat has a variety of security measures that are simple to use. You can block who sends you snaps or change who can see your story by clicking the top right hand corner, scrolling to 'Who Can' and choosing the option you want. Don't forget to press the back button to save your selection.
Soundcloud	With Soundcloud, you can block an account from following or interacting with you by going to their profile and clicking on the three dots in the top right. Simply click on the 'Block' option. A few options will come up, just pick the ones that suit you and hit 'Block'.
Steam	Steam has its own online safety tool 'Steam Guard' you can enable this in your 'Account Details' section then head to 'Account Security'. This will help protect your account.
Tango	Simply head to a users profile page, click in the upper right corner and select 'Block this person' to block a contact with Tango.
Tumblr	To ensure your blog is secure, you can change your blog's privacy and security settings in the blog main menu. From here you can limit who sees the blog, who can ask questions, who can message you and you can block people.
Twitch	Twitch's security setting allow you to 'Ignore' any inappropriate or harassing comments by simply tapping on their username and selecting 'Ignore' so you don't need to see anything from them again.
Twitter	Twitter allows you to keep your account private so you can protect your tweets and stop people sending you direct messages. Head to your settings to ensure you're being safe online.
Viber	Viber allows you to block users by simply swiping your screen to the left, clicking on the contact, 'More' then 'Block'. This is handy as you can also block people in group chats.

WhatsApp	If someone is sending unwanted or inappropriate messages on WhatsApp, you can block that person by clicking on that contact and selecting 'Block this Contact' they will no longer be able to send anything to you.
Younow	Younow has live moderators that will review and act when you flag a user. You can also block any user from posting on your profile or interacting in your broadcasts by clicking on the user's name, then the red flag icon in their mini-profile, and select the 'Block' option.
YouTube	YouTube has a handy function that means you can restrict content based on age restrictions and community flagging. This prevents any surprises coming up on your YouTube feed. Simply click on 'Restricted Mode On/Off' to manage your preferences which is either in 'Settings' on an app or down the bottom of the page on a desktop version.
