Vocabulary	
mark	the word used to describe different lines, patterns and textures in art
line	can be curved or straight and vary in width or texture
pattern	a repeated decorative design
repeat	to do again and again
variety	different, diverse
tone	Chiaroscuro - refers to the use of light and dark in an artwork
pressure	force (pressing hard or softly)
graphite	a drawing medium - only requires slight pressure to leave a mark
horizontal	(a line that goes) straight across from left to right
vertical	(a line that goes) straight up and down
parallel	(lines that are) equally distanced and never meet
blend	gently intermingling two or more colours or shades, used to soften lines
enlarge	to make bigger
scale	to make bigger or smaller but keeping the same proportions
