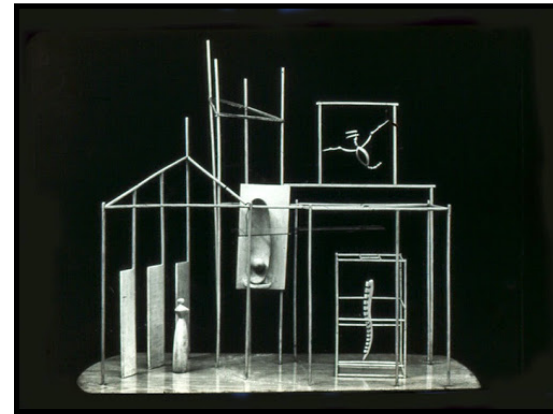


## Vocabulary

joints	a point at which parts of a structure are joined
sculptural	relating to or resembling sculpture (3D artwork)
figurative	art that derives from life - not necessarily realistic but recognisable
limited palette	to limit how many colours you use
translucent	allowing light but not detailed shapes to pass through
form	shape or structure
inlay	for a design, pattern or piece of material to be embedded



What media and tools we'll need:

cardboard tubes

tissue paper

clay

art straws

sticks

modroc

masking tape

drawing pencils

PVA glue

cling film



We are going to be looking at the figurative sculptures of Alberto Giacometti and responding to his work by making drawings of figures in the distance that we will then make 3D using modroc.

- How to make a tissue bowl:
1. Cover the form with cling film and fasten with masking tape.
  2. Select your tissue paper colours.
  3. Coat the cling film with PVA glue and overlap the coloured tissue.
  4. Cover the finished bowl with a last layer of PVA.
  5. Remove bowl from form and trim away cling film.
