Specific strategies are used in **music** lessons to support children with SEND as detailed below.

<p>Physical and Sensory Needs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Modelling in both instrument and musicianship lessons.- Learning is chunked into small steps which build on previous knowledge.- Ear defenders/plugs provided during orchestra rehearsals.	<p>Social and Emotional Needs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Musicians/session leaders selected to suit the needs of the pupils.- Mixed ability instrument lessons support pupil progress.- Limited focus on written tasks, practical nature.
<p>Cognition and Learning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Musicianship linked to instrument lessons to support learning of skills and theory.- Wide range of tasks and techniques used to support learners.- Retrieval of previous learning completed across all three sessions.	<p>Communication and Interaction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Access to KO at home to support with pre-learning/when practicing at home.- Collaboration in orchestra weekly.- Termly sharings/performances to pupils, staff and parents.- Collaboration with other schools during performances.
