When joining the lesson....

Be in one of your family rooms e.g.
dining room.
Not your
bedroom



Be on time for the lesson and wait for the teacher to let you in



Have all your
equipment
ready including
paper and
pencil.



Make sure you are on mute.
Only unmute if you are asked to.



When taking part in the lesson...

Behave as you would in the school class, listen carefully at all times.



Complete tasks along with the teacher to support your learning.



Do not film or screenshot any part of the lesson.



At the end of the lesson listen to any tasks or practise you need to complete before the next lesson.
