Climate change is something that affects us all. We have the right to give our opinions about how we can help tackle climate change and adults should listen and take us seriously.



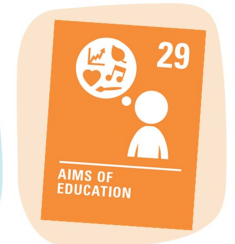
